

August BOE Report

The tax rate was approved and verified at \$3.6929 per \$100 assessed valuation. The Budget hearing was held in conjunction with the tax rate summary. The board voted to place \$3.1149 in fund 1 and .5780 cents in fund 4 capital improvements. The capital improvement levy generated will be used for the building and maintenance projects.

A thank you card was read from Debbie Loucks.

The board readopted Financial Disclosure policy 0342 and policy 1110 Religious Expression. Mrs. Loucks was appointed custodian of records. Mr. Miles was appointed to be the Homeless/Migrant Coordinator as well as the English Limited Language Coordinator. The Local SPED Compliance Plan was approved as was the tuition rate of \$3500 per year. The board also approved the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch Policy.

The milk bid was awarded to Hiland Dairy and no bread bids were received.

The board approved ACES Coop contracts for behavior analysis Sally Crumb, Speech Language Pathologists Donna Pile and Susan Buessing-Long, Wolf Physical Therapy, and CSI Head Start Social Work.

Ms. Flint reported Back to School Night was well attended. The teacher in-services were going well and looking forward to working more on the Missouri Model District project with the staff.

Mr. Miles mentioned eighty six students are enrolled in high school. Volleyball begins the 25th with the East Atchison Tournament, Varsity football begins next Friday with Platte Valley and Cross Country begins the 28th at North Platte.

Mr. Eaton reported on the progress of the epoxy floors, bleacher renovations and general maintenance of the facilities.
